Recently, one of my doctor friends visited the USA for a vacation. While bathing in a waterfall, he suddenly collapsed. Thankfully, a fellow tourist immediately performed CPR and rushed him to the nearest hospital. He survived and later returned to India. However, I can't help but think that had he been in India, the outcome might have been different.

This experience has made me realize the critical importance of CPR training for the public, particularly for auto and taxi drivers, as well as police personnel, who are often the first to respond in emergencies. With their swift action and proper training, many lives could be saved. Offering CPR training to these individuals would equip them with the skills to act quickly in life-threatening situations, potentially making all the difference.

Additionally, placing Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) in high-traffic areas, such as public events, marketplaces, and transport hubs, could significantly improve survival rates in emergencies. Ensuring that CPR-trained personnel are available at such locations would further increase the chances of a positive outcome when every second counts.

A proactive approach like this could not only save lives but also raise awareness about the importance of emergency preparedness. Even if we save just one life through these efforts, it would be a tremendous achievement. I firmly believe that widespread CPR training and the availability of AEDs could have a transformative impact on public health and safety in India, fostering a culture of life -saving readiness across the country.
